

## Letter Rogatory

**From:** The Sovereign Andrea Rose, Bailey

**To:** The Sovereign Clayton Atwood, in his personal capacity

**Intent:** To peaceably co-exist with the de facto government of Catron County

Greetings Clay,

**In good faith** I address this communiqué to you in your personal capacity and trust that you will fully understand that all proceedings of a judicial nature in no way diminish the honor and respect in which I hold you personally.

The Founding Fathers of this great American Republic stated in the Declaration of Independence: *“We hold these truths to be self-evident, that all men are created equal, that they are endowed by their Creator with certain unalienable rights, that among these are life, liberty and the pursuit of happiness. **That to secure these rights, governments are instituted among men, deriving their just powers from the consent of the governed.** That whenever any form of government becomes destructive to these ends, it is the right of the people to alter or to abolish it, and to institute new government, laying its foundation on such principles and organizing its powers in such form, as to them shall seem most likely to effect their safety and happiness.”*

That Republic which they founded has lain dormant since 1861 until re-inhabited in 2010. It is my intent and purpose in contesting the Constitutionality of local police actions, to include setting up “check points” that the People of the Republic should not be subjected to tyrannical quasi-governmental activities designed and intended to generate revenue. This in no way interferes with such activities as they relate to the subjects of the corporate de facto government and should not have any significant impact on the revenue generated by such activities, or the corporate government’s ability to pay tribute to the International Banking Cartel who own and operates such quasi-governmental corporations.

**We ask only that the de facto government not interfere with the free People of the Catron County free Settlement in the Republic for the state of New Mexico for any reason.** We have our own laws, our own enforcement personnel, our own judicial system and have no need for any guidance nor assistance from the de facto corporate government.

However, we would be honored if you, *personally*, would accept an honorary position as a judicial advisor for the Judicial Branch as we develop our judicial system in order to effectively serve the needs and desires of **the People of the free Catron County Settlement.**
